## BACKGROUND

National Grid has established a scholarship program to assist those who plan to continue their education at Hudson Valley Community College in Troy, New York.

Scholarships will be prioritized for applicants who self-identify as a member of one or more under-represented groups in the industry.

## ELIGIBILITY

- Be current high school seniors or have a high school diploma or have received a GED.
- Plan to enroll in part time or full time at Hudson Valley Community College in Troy NY for upcoming academic year to obtain either an:

Electrical Construction  
Maintenance Degree

OR

Overhead Line  
Workers Certificate

## SELECTION

Scholarship selected based on:

- Academic record & work experience
- Demonstrated leadership & participation in school or community events
- Financial need
- Unusual personal or family circumstances
- Personal statement on why applicant is pursuing degree

Up to 13 scholarships will be awarded for the 2025-2026 academic year.

## APPLICATION WINDOW

**JANUARY 30, 2025  
TO APRIL 14, 2025**

## REQUIREMENTS

Hudson Valley Community College requires the following academic requirements:

- Algebra or 1 unit of academic math (70 or above). Additional math courses are recommended
- High School overall average of 70 or above

## AWARDS

Up to **\$7,000** annually for tuition, fees, and books. National Grid will also purchase required tool kits for scholars.

## NOTIFICATION

All applicants will be notified in **early June** of the status of their application.

## PAYMENT

Scholarship America processes scholarship payments on behalf of National Grid. Payment is made in **early August**.
